- Bid on shifts to get the overtime and/or extra shift you want
- Trade shifts with employees that work alternate days, alternate locations or shifts
- Get access to open shifts on a first come first served basis
- Part time employees can define days/hours that they cannot work
- Call off your shift or part of your shift and have a trackable history of your submission
